On Thursday, March 29, 2012, Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) David M. Lee of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) contacted Crime Intelligence Analyst (IA) Amanda B. Stephens and requested a trace be conducted with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATFE), on the hand gun used to shoot Trayvon Martin. The request was made in reference to the February 26, 2012, shooting death of Martin.

IA Stephens was requested to conduct an E-trace on the Keltec, PF-9, 9mm pistol, Serial Number [REDACTED] used by George Zimmerman to shoot Martin.

On Wednesday, April 4, 2012, IA Stephens received a report from ATEF who provided the following information.

The weapon was purchased on November 11, 2009, by Shellie Zimmerman, (wife of George Zimmerman) at Shoot Straight II Inc., 4700 S. Hwy 17-92, Casselberry, Florida.

The report will be maintained as a related item to this case.
